This simple document will explain how to work with SheetMuse.

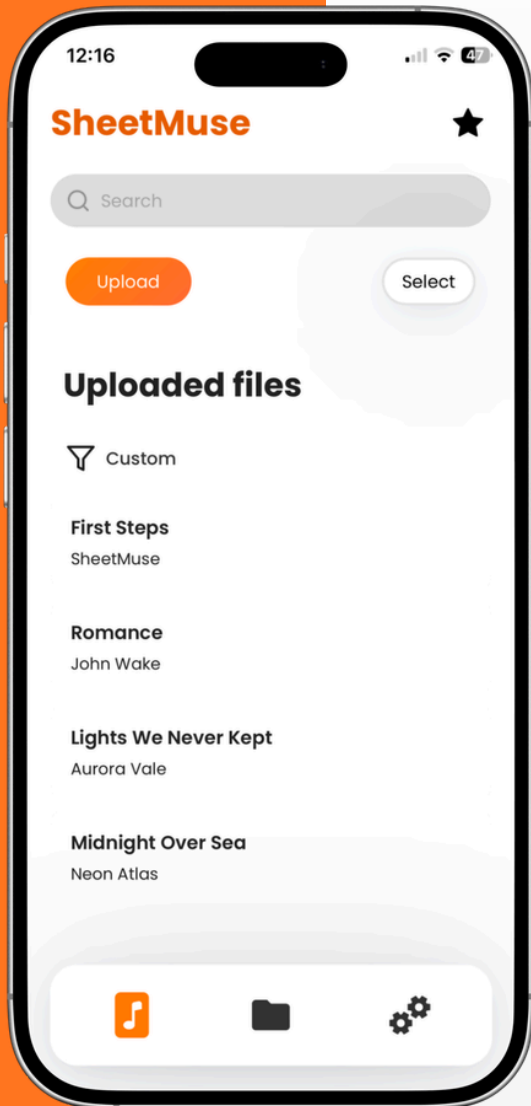

File management

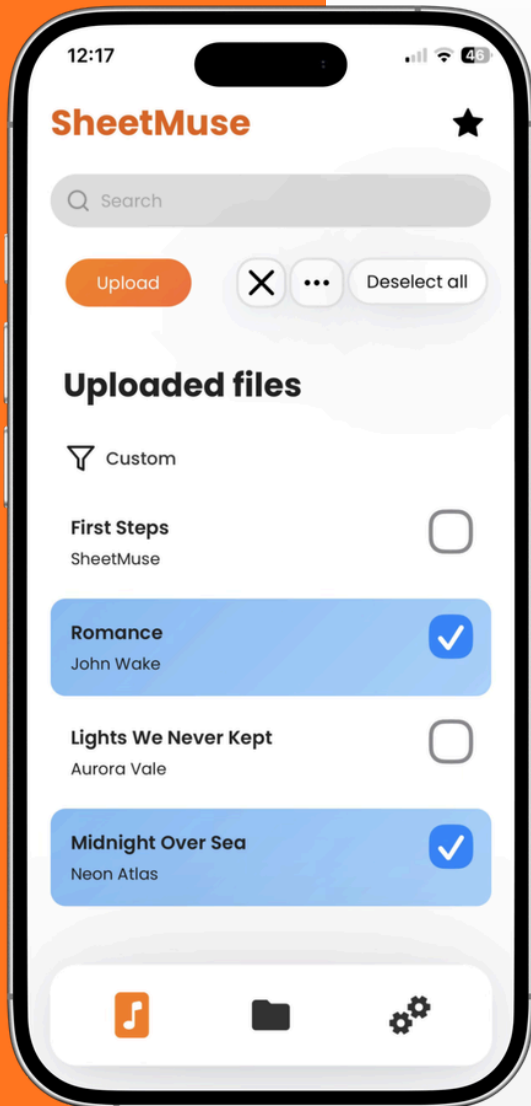


Once logged in, a similar screen will appear. Click the **Upload** button to add your PDFs from your device's memory. On tablets, you can also drag files directly into the dedicated area (drag & drop).

Use the **Search** Bar and **filters** at the top to quickly find a file. You can sort the list by name or date. By selecting "Custom" sorting, you can adjust the file order by long-pressing an item and dragging it to the desired location.



File management



Multiple Selection: Click "Select" to activate bulk management.

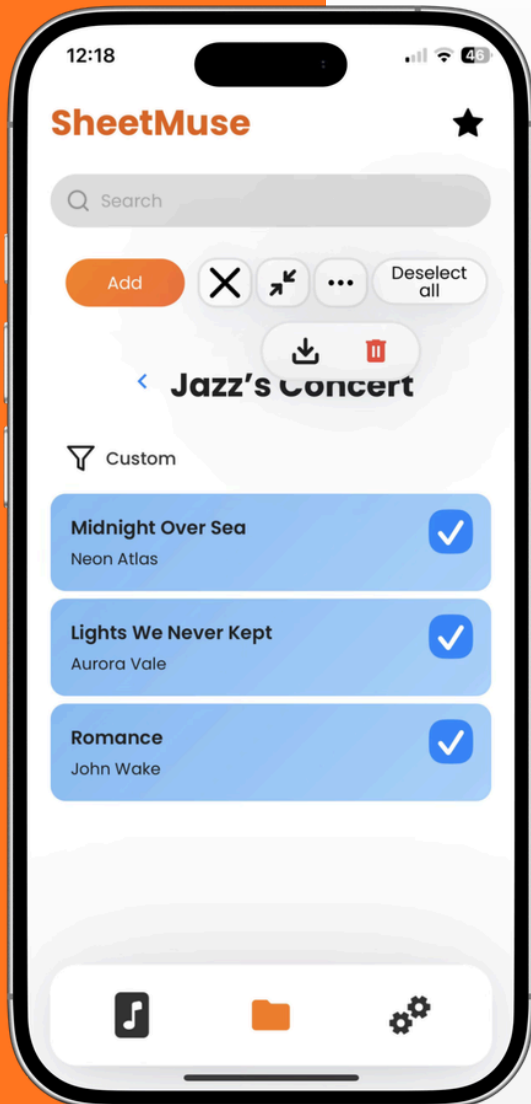
The toolbar will change depending on the section:

In **Files Mode:** You can Select All, Bulk Add to a Setlist, or Permanently Delete files (remove from device and cloud).

In **Setlist Mode:** You can Rename the space or Delete it (the original PDFs will remain in the library).



File management



Within a Setlist: You can view selected songs in fullscreen, export them, or remove them exclusively from that specific setlist.

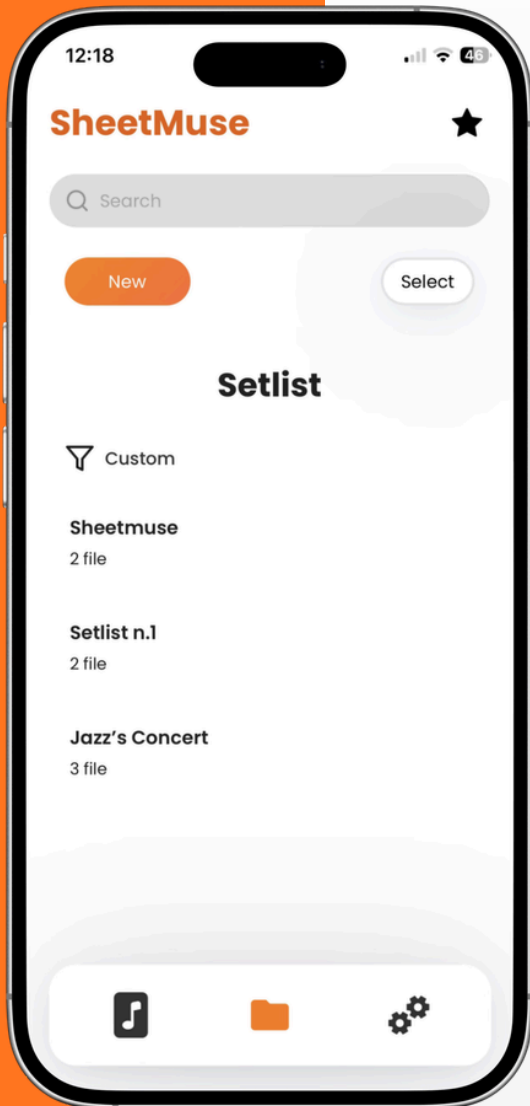
- **Maximum Safety Limit (50 MB):** If the total size of the PDFs in the setlist exceeds 50 MB, the operation will be blocked. The app will warn you and ask you to split the setlist into two smaller parts.
- **Safe Mode (25 - 50 MB):** The export is successful, but to avoid overloading the storage, the files are exported in their original version (without annotations). Songs not yet downloaded from the cloud will be skipped, with a summary at the end.



Creation of setlists

By clicking on the folder icon (bottom center), we access the spaces section (setlist):

- **New Setlist:** Go to the "Setlist" section and click "New" to create a folder or dedicated setlist (e.g., "Jazz Concert").
- **Organization:** Within each setlist, you can add songs from your general library and rearrange them according to their performance order.

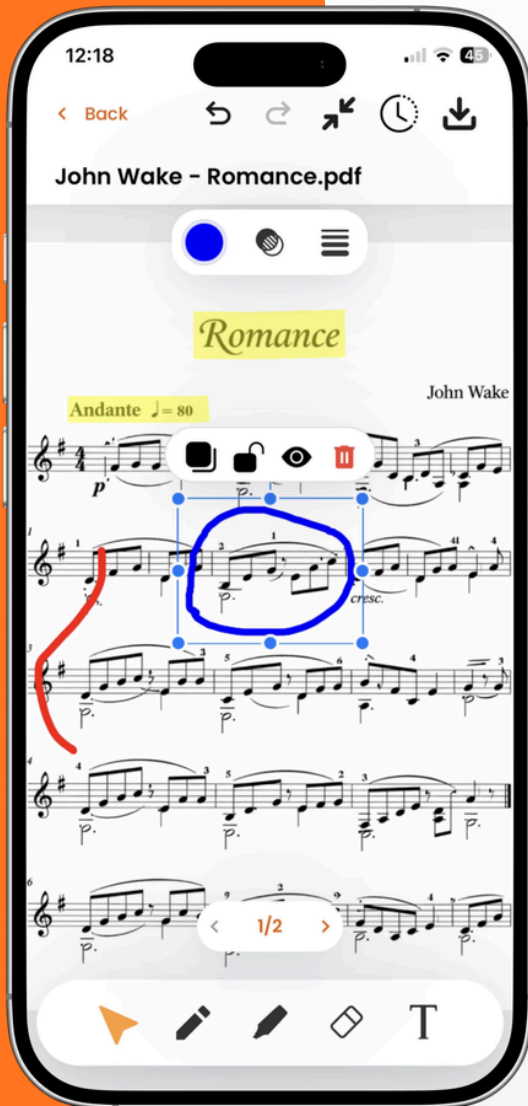




PDF Editor

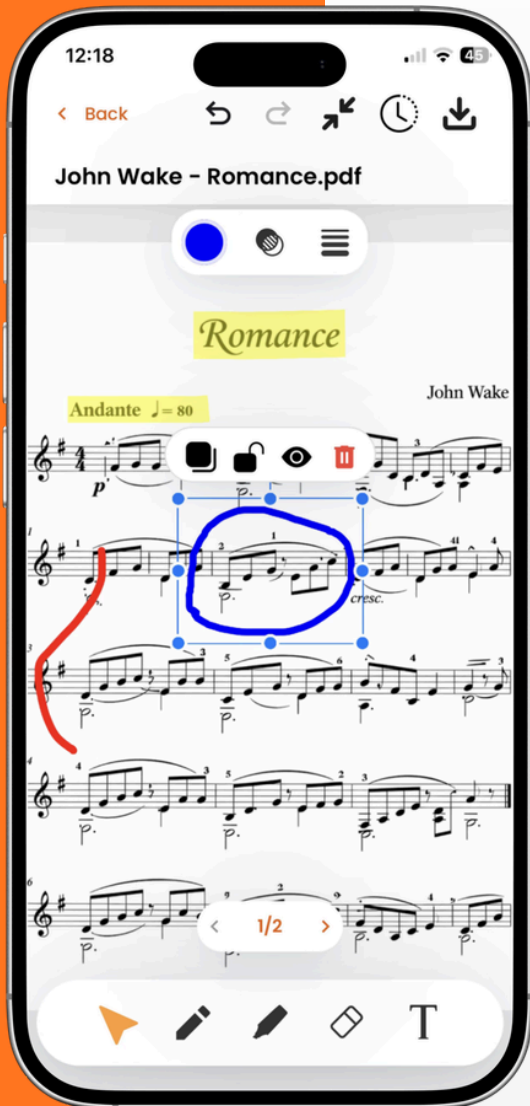
Click on a file to open it. In this mode, you have a complete toolbar at your disposal:

- **Drawing Tools:** Pen for writing notes and Highlighter for marking important passages.
- **Text:** Add typed comments, choosing the font, size, color, and background.
- **Select and Edit:** Use the Select tool to move, resize, duplicate, or delete existing annotations.





PDF Editor



- **Object Properties:** Clicking on the selected object displays a floating toolbar anchored to the object for certain functions, such as duplicating or locking objects. A contextual toolbar appears at the top, depending on the type of object selected, with related information (color, transparency, formatting keys, etc.).
- **Undo/Redo:** Undo or redo the latest changes using the up arrow keys.

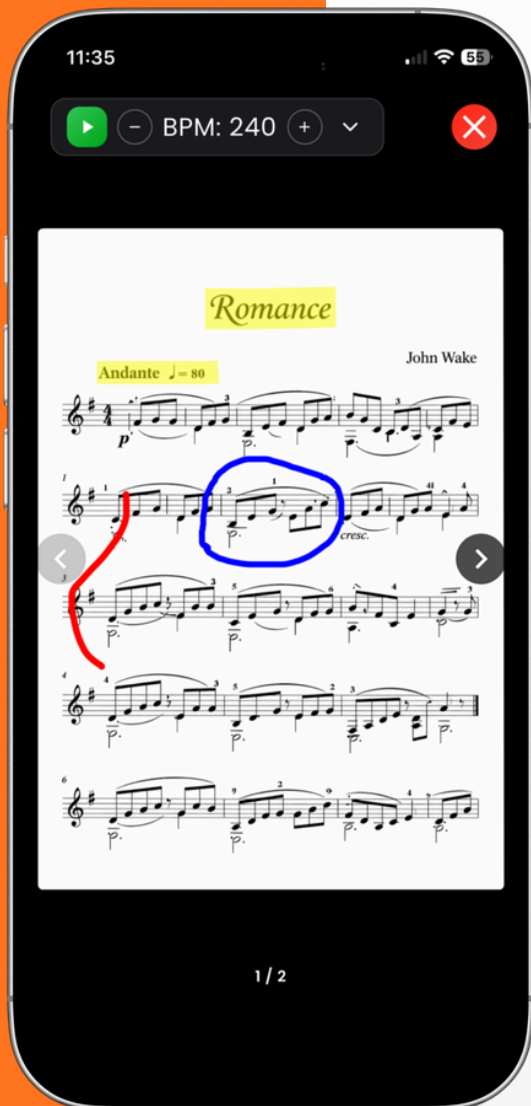
- **Pinch Zoom and Navigation:** You can zoom in on sheet music details using the classic pinch-zoom gesture (spreading your fingers on the screen). Use the Lock Zoom button if you want to lock the zoom level while navigating between pages.
- **Download PDF:** Once you've completed your edits, you can download a copy of the PDF file that includes all your graphic and text annotations, ready to print or share.



Fullscreen PDF

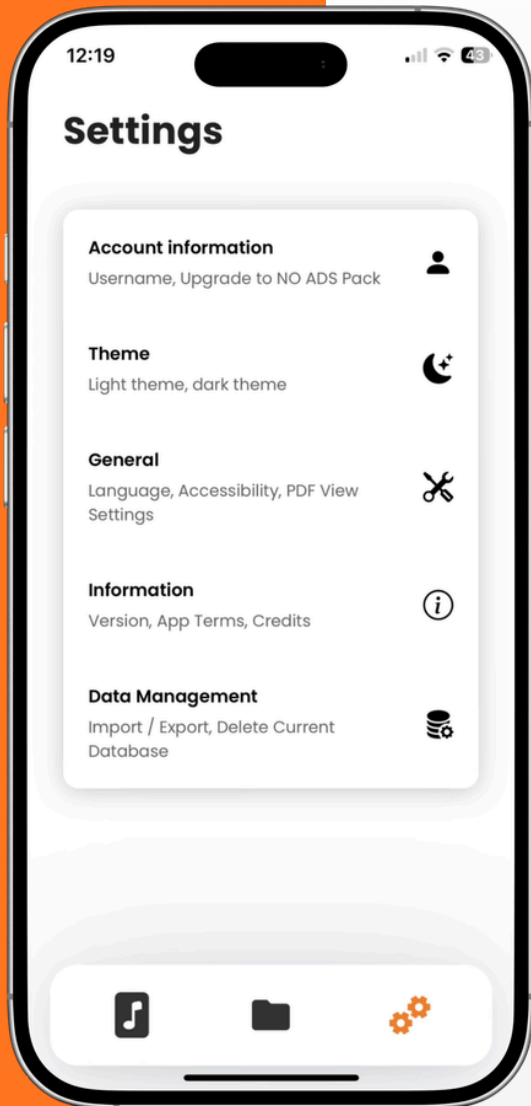
This mode allows you to show only the PDF.

- **Activation:** You can enter Fullscreen by tapping the dedicated icon in the toolbar or within a setlist menu (using the shortcut keys).
- **Full Control:** While reading in fullscreen, you can scroll through pages using the buttons, double-tapping the PDF (left-right or up-down), or using compatible Bluetooth footswitches.
- **Metronome:** In this mode, the metronome will automatically appear or hide based on your preferences saved in the settings.
- **Quick Exit:** To go back, simply press the red close button (X) in the top right.





Settings

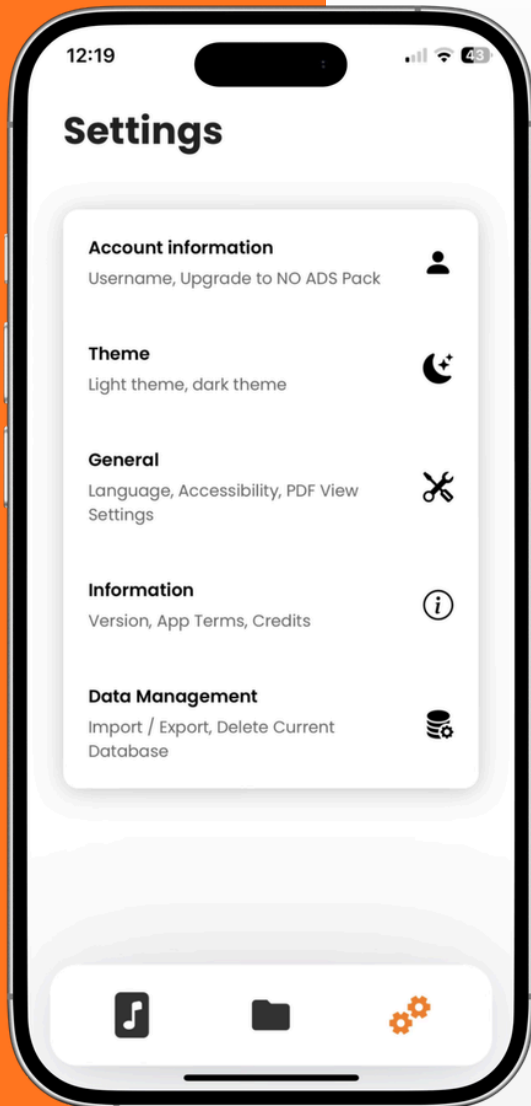


SheetMuse allows you to tailor your work environment to your specific needs through several dedicated sections:

- **Login Information:** In this section, you can view the email address associated with your account, change your username, and manage the status of the NO ADS Pack to remove ads.
- **Theme:** Customize the visual appearance by enabling or disabling Dark Mode.



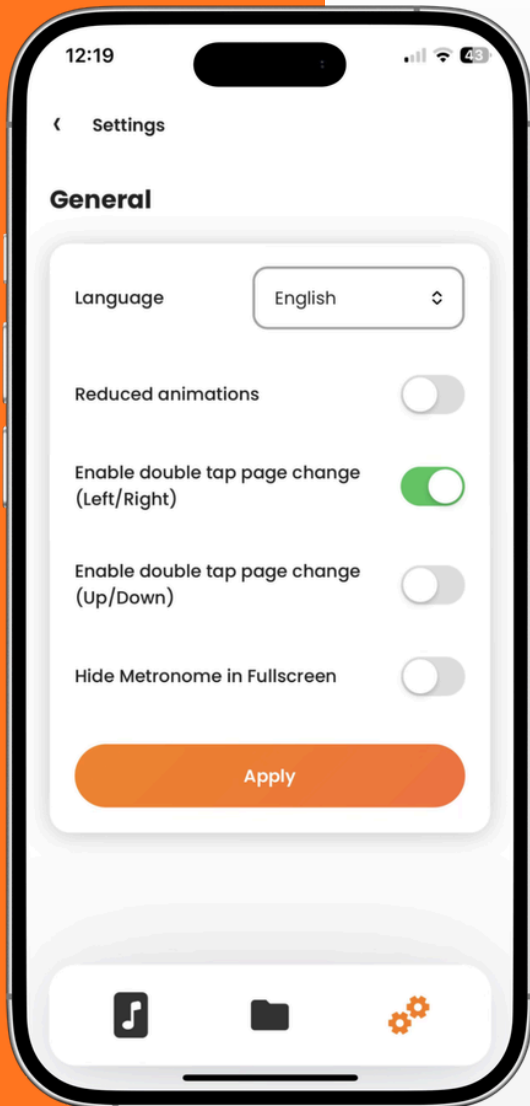
Settings



- **General and Accessibility:** From here, you can change the app language (Italian, English, Spanish) and enable Minimal Animations to improve fluidity on older devices.
- **Info:** Here, you can view the app version and documents such as Terms and Conditions and more.



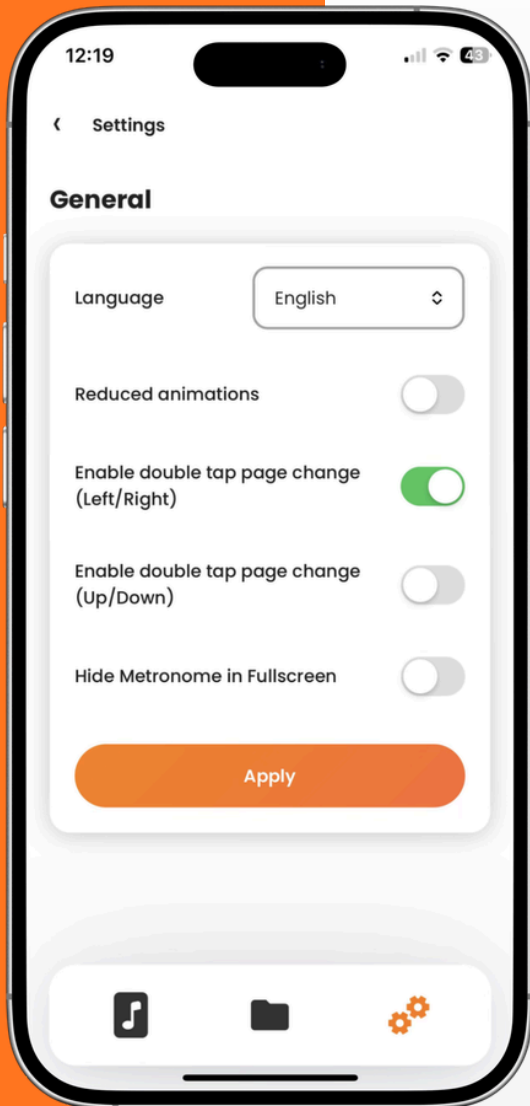
Settings



- **PDF Viewing:** This advanced section allows you to configure the reading experience:
- **Double Page:** Enables double-page view for PDF previews (only if you're in landscape orientation and have a large device).
- **Double Tap:** Configures quick page switching with a double tap (Left/Right or Up/Down).



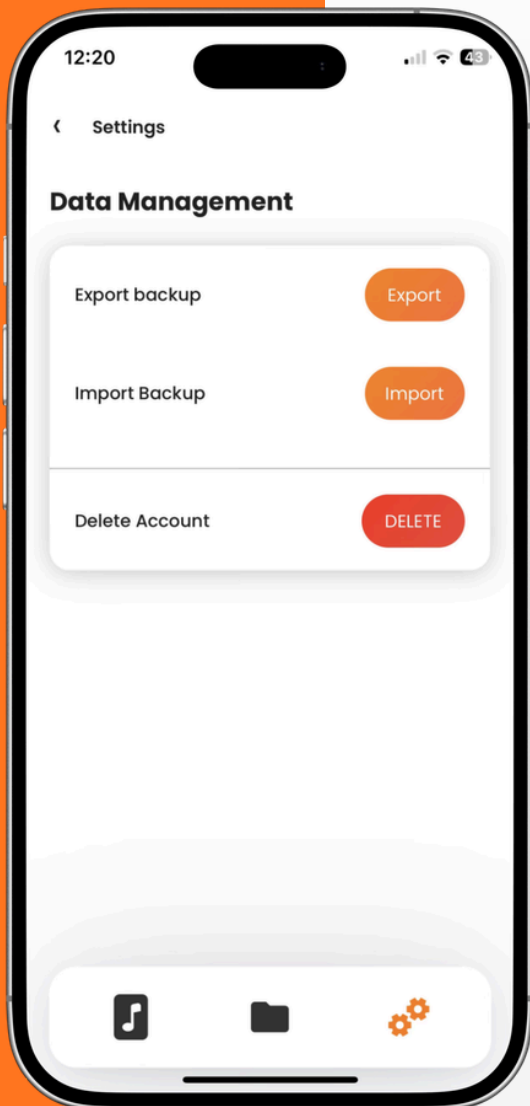

- **FS Metronome:** Choose whether to automatically hide or show the metronome when you enter fullscreen mode.
- **Bluetooth:** Make sure the Bluetooth pedal is paired with your device to enable faster fullscreen navigation.



Data management

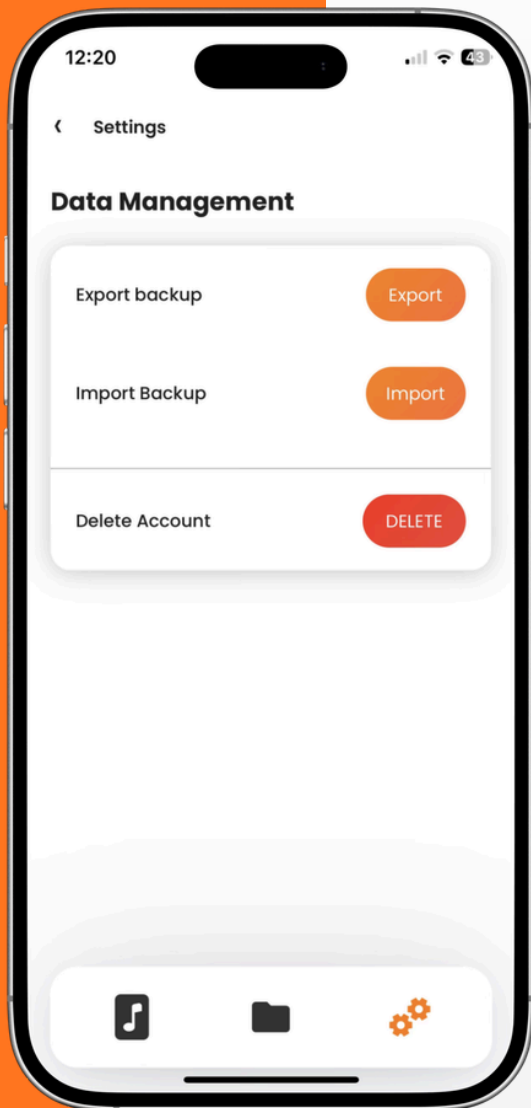


Essential tools for securing your songs. You can export a full backup in JSON, import previously saved data, or use Account Deletion to permanently delete your data from your device and cloud storage.

- **Backup Limit (50 MB):** To ensure app stability and prevent memory crashes, exporting will fail if the total file size exceeds 50 MB. In this case, we recommend exporting individual Setlists separately.

Save Destination (iOS/Android Difference)

- **iOS (Apple):** Once the ZIP or PDF export is complete, the native Apple menu will open. To physically save the file, scroll down and click "Save to Files." Alternatively, if the native menu doesn't open, the file will automatically be saved to the app folder within the "Files" app > "On iPad/iPhone" > "SheetMuse" > "Documents" app.
- **Android:** The export will use the system sharing menu or save the file directly to the device's public "Downloads" folder.



NO-ADS PACK

Purchase the NO-ADS Pack to permanently remove banners and in-text videos.

If you don't want to purchase the NO-ADS version, you can watch a short video ad to unlock 15 minutes of ad-free usage.



User experience

SheetMuse was designed with a "Tablet-First" approach. Although the application is fully compatible with smartphones, the interface and annotation system have been optimized for maximum performance on large screens (tablets and iPads).

- **Optimal Layout:** The proportions of the menus and toolbar are calibrated to ensure maximum readability of A4 or Letter-sized scores, minimizing visual distractions.
- **Annotation Precision:** Using a tablet, preferably combined with a digital pen (stylus), allows for surgical precision in handwritten strokes and notes, faithfully simulating the experience of writing on paper.



User experience

- **Professional View:** Thanks to intelligent space management, tablets can take full advantage of Double Page View, making reading complex pieces much smoother during practice or concerts.
- **Hardware and Memory (RAM) Requirements:** Managing high-resolution PDF files and real-time rendering of freehand annotations require adequate resources. For stable and smooth use, devices with at least 4 GB of RAM (minimum requirement) are recommended.
- **Offline Mode:** You can read previously downloaded files and use the app even without an internet connection, ideal for on-stage use. However, without a network connection, cloud synchronization, adding new files, or structural changes to setlists or annotations will not be active until the connection is restored.



User experience

For professional musicians who manage extensive setlists, very large PDFs, or require extreme multitasking on stage, devices with 6 GB or 8 GB of RAM (or higher) are strongly recommended. Ample RAM prevents unexpected page reloads in the background and ensures that pen input is always responsive and lag-free.

The user acknowledges that use on devices with lower specifications may cause instability or unexpected app termination.
