

Terms and Conditions

1. Purpose of the service:

SheetMuse is a mobile application available for Android and iOS, developed using Capacitor technology. It enables users, upon registration, to upload, view, and annotate digital sheet music, organize setlists, and manage musical content for personal use. The application provides local storage and cloud synchronization features, facilitating access to data across multiple devices linked to the same account.

2. Acceptance of the Terms:

Utilization of the application signifies complete acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. Registration, login, and ongoing use of the application represent explicit acceptance. Should you disagree with any portion of these Terms and Conditions, you are required to cease use and uninstall the application.

3. Usage criteria:

The user asserts to:

- Possess the legal capacity to enter into this agreement.
- Utilize the application solely for legal and personal purposes.
- Do not infringe upon the rights of third parties, especially in accordance with relevant copyright and intellectual property legislation.
- Refrain from utilizing the App for the unauthorized dissemination or distribution of copyrighted material.
- In the event of a violation, SheetMuse retains the right to suspend or terminate the user's account without prior notice.

4. User-uploaded content:

All uploaded files and annotations remain the exclusive property of the user. Role of SheetMuse: The application functions solely as a technical tool and asserts no rights over the user's content. Storage: PDF files and their associated metadata (titles, BPM, annotations) are stored on the device and, for registered users, synchronized through cloud services (Firebase). This synchronization is designed exclusively to enhance the user's personal use across multiple devices. Responsibility: The user bears full responsibility for the legality of the uploaded files. SheetMuse does not conduct any preliminary content checks and disclaims all liability for copyright infringements committed by the user.

5. Data Preservation and Backup:

While the app provides a cloud synchronization feature, data persistence cannot be assured. Users must retain an original copy of their PDFs outside the application. SheetMuse disclaims any responsibility for data loss due to technical failures, inadvertent cache deletions, device resets, or cloud service disruptions. It is advisable to regularly utilize the Export Backup feature found in the settings.

6. Ad-Free Version and Premium Features:

SheetMuse is funded through advertisements (AdMob).

- **NO ADS Pack:** You can permanently eliminate advertisements through an in-app purchase for €1.99.
- **Temporary Access (Rewarded Video):** The user has the option to watch a brief advertising video in exchange for 15 minutes of "Premium" mode usage (free from banners and interruptions).
- **Purchase Management and Platform Restriction:** Payments are exclusively processed and managed through the billing systems of the Google Play Store and Apple App Store. Consequently, the acquisition of the "NO ADS" package is legally tied to the device's native account (Google Account or Apple ID) rather than to SheetMuse's internal synchronization account. SheetMuse does not retain any payment information and is unable to process refunds or address issues related to external billing systems. While the developer provides, as a courtesy and additional feature, the capability to synchronize "Premium" status across multiple devices logged into the same SheetMuse account (even across different platforms), the original purchase and associated license remain strictly governed by the terms and conditions of the store where the transaction was completed.

7. Limitation of Liability:

The application is offered "as is" without any warranties. Under no circumstances shall the developer be liable for: Loss or corruption of data or annotations; PDF display errors or delays in cloud synchronization; Damage arising from the inability to access the application during a live performance; Misuse of the application or copyright infringement by the user.

The developer retains the right to modify or discontinue the service at any time. Users may delete their accounts and associated cloud data through the designated function in the app settings.
